## Heterosexual Masculinities

### Contemporary Perspectives from Psychoanalytic Gender Theory

In recent years there have been substantial changes in approaches to how genders are made and what functions genders fulfill. Most of the scholarly focus in this area has been in the areas of feminist, gay, and lesbian studies. Heterosexual masculinity, which tended to be defined by lack and absence, has not received the critical and scholarly attention of these other areas. *Heterosexual Masculinities* rethinks a psychoanalytic tradition that has long thought masculinity as a sort of brittle defense against femininity, softness, and emotionality.
